The State of Hawaii Department of Transportation (HDOT) is planning improvements to Honoapi'ilani Highway (State Route 30) between Launiupoko and Ukumehame. This addresses the roadway's vulnerability to coastal hazards and sea level rise.

HDOT is preparing an Environmental Impact Statement, in compliance with the National Environmental Planning Act and Chapter 343 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS 343), to evaluate and disclose the project's potential environmental impacts and identify permitting requirements. Both State and federal funds will be used for this project, including a \$22 million Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity construction grant.
